IndustriALL Global Union in solidarity with Jabil workers at the Marcianise plant

Dear Sister Francesca, and Brothers Marco, and Rocco,

I am writing this letter to you on behalf of [IndustriALL Global Union](http://www.industriall-union.org)'s more than fifty million workers in mining, energy and manufacturing sectors throughout the world, including Italy, to express our full support and solidarity with the Jabil Circuit Italia workers and their families, who are fighting against the unfair dismissal of 190 workers at the Marcianise plant.

IndustriALL Global Union is outraged to learn of the company's unilateral decision to dismiss the 190 workers in the middle of the Covid-19 pandemic, without proper consultation with concerned unions. We fully understand the dismissal is irresponsible by the company which is recognized as one of the largest electronics manufacturing company. We believe that the company should commit to sustain

Jabil Circuit Italy, which is recognized as one of the largest electronics manufacturing companies with a net revenue for the quarter 2020 of 6.1 billion USD, should behave responsibly vis-à-vis its workforce, including their families and communities.

Therefore, IndustriALL Global Union demands that Jabil engage in consultations with FIOM-CGIL, FIM-CISL, and UILM, and with the government to find a fair and sustainable solution, which guarantees job security, including the immediate reinstatement of the 190 workers at the Marcianise plant, and thus minimizes the economic and social impact of the pandemic on workers and the community at large.
